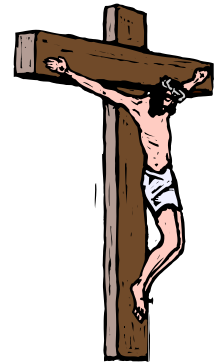

Year 2 Trip To London Zoo

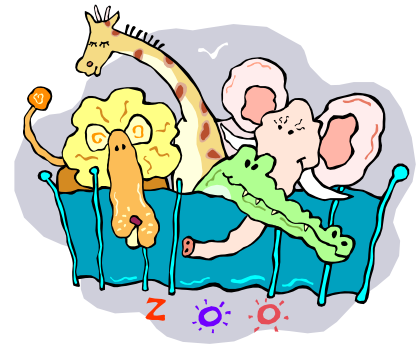
Year 2 classes had a fantastic day at London Zoo which was organised to support their current and future learning on the themes of variation, homes and nocturnal animals.
