Autumn 2019 – 2020

This is a guide of all the programme strands of the Education Programme in Brent 2020 delivered by A New Direction. It includes descriptions of all the strands that you can use to communicate to your teams.

Cultural Leads

50 educators have signed up to be an ambassador for Brent 2020 and champion creativity in their settings and across the borough during the year of culture and beyond. They are participating in a leadership development programme (termly meetings) and contribute to the development of the ABC of Brent Resource Pack and the Local Cultural Education Partnership. They will represent Brent 2020 as a Hub School or EY setting to support other educators in their locality.

Cultural Champions

Our ambition is to have every educational setting in Brent engage in the London Borough of Culture and are inviting every school and early years setting to nominate Cultural Champions. They will be invited to training, events, and to connect with the Cultural Leads in their local hub school/setting. This will ensure they stay up to date with opportunities and that Brent 2020 reaches every child and young person in the borough.

ABC of Brent Resource Pack

A learning resource for schools and educational settings to help educators engage with LBOC programme and to connect children and young people creatively with their local area, their heritage and their hopes for the future.

The resource pack will spark creative ideas, generate learning opportunities beyond the classroom and connect you with events and activities across the Brent 2020 programme.

Cultural Connections Events

Cultural Connections is a series of events running throughout 2019-2020, bringing together educators, organisations and artists working in Brent. A space to share ideas, opportunities, network and make things happen!

CPD

There are bespoke training opportunities for all Brent educators during the year of Culture focusing on creativity, fundraising and wellbeing.

Creative arts sessions in November and February will focus on the ABC of Brent resource. It will link to the key themes of the Brent 2020 programme Place, Stories, Home & Future and enable you to plan your Take Part projects.

The fundraising sessions in Autumn 2019 and Autumn 2020 will help you make successful applications and get creative work funded in your settings.

Take Part

Take Part is your chance to showcase the full power of creativity happening in your school / setting. This can happen at any point during the year of culture, but there will be a festival of participation during 6th –11th July 2020 culminating in the Street Party on Saturday 11th July. We want Hubs and Cultural Leads to host, plan and curate performances, exhibitions and concerts during this week.

There will also be opportunities to showcase your creative work during Autumn term 2020.
