Please continue to support your child with putting on and taking off their coat.

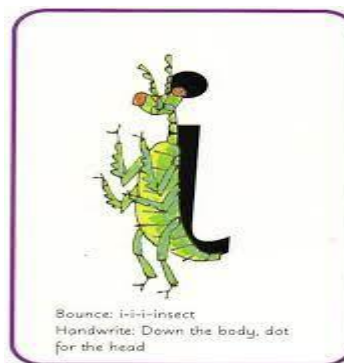
Mathematics: Number 6
