Mathematics: number 7

The children are continuing to look at and learn their numbers up to 10. This week they are using the cubes to build number towers up to 7.

They are also continuing to learn to how to use the 10 frame by putting the correct amount of cubes to represent the number 7.

Lots of children are really trying hard and are beginning to form some letters and even write their name. If your child is struggling to write their name get them to write just some of the letters first and then eventually they will have a go at writing all of their name.
