Encourage your child to put on and take off their blazers and jumpers independently. Make sure that they know where to find the label with their names written so they can easily identify them.

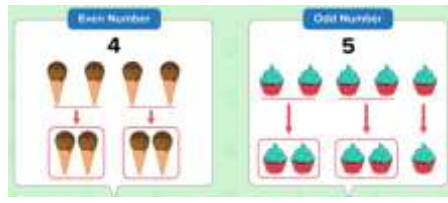

RSHE - God is Love

This session tied into the EYFS topic 'people who help us'. The children identified those who help us in an emergency. The children also discussed which emergency service they might need in specific scenarios and the principle of Emergences and non-emergences.

Mathematics

This week the children built upon their knowledge of grouping. The children also explored sharing (odd and even) and identifying fair and unfair by looking at the objects that are left over. The children also explored doubles and how to find and make them.



Literacy/ imagine: Fairy Tales



This week the children received a surprising letter from Fairy tale land. This week we focused on the Big Bad Wolf and how he is always a mischievous character.

The children thought of the different roles the Big Bad Wolf had in different stories like the Three Little Pigs and Peter and the Wolf. The children also thought of adjectives to describe the Wolf and wrote a sentence using the adjective to describe the wolf.

Religious Education

This week the children learnt about St Peter and St Paul. We learnt that they were very special friends of Jesus. The children thought about what makes a good friend and what they can do to be an even better friend, to follow in Jesus' footsteps, like St Peter and Paul.
