Mathematics

Get your child to write their numbers daily. Remind them how to write their numbers correctly if they write them the wrong way.

Talk about numbers when you are out and about. What numbers can you see, what is the number on our door etc?

Things to do at home:

Please continue to support your child during the summer holidays with writing their name, sounds cvc words e.g.: cat, mat, hat, dog, log, jog etc. These are rhyming words and are a way for your child to start writing rhyming lists.

Remember to use your child's name card to remind them on how to write their name correctly.

Continue to read stories to your child every day and get your child to talk about the book, the characters, their favourite part and why they liked the story.

Talk to your child about what they see when you are out and about and what they liked about it etc.
